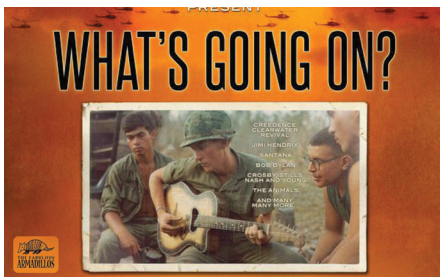

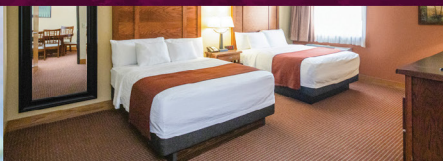

Teran Girmscheid (Judy Bernly)

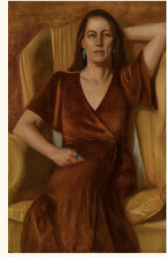

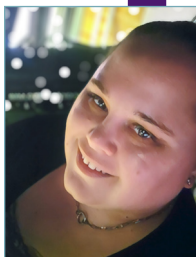
Sammi Benson (Detective/Ensemble)

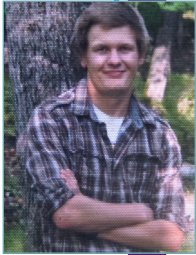
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Dakira Dagenais (Candy Striper/Ensemble)

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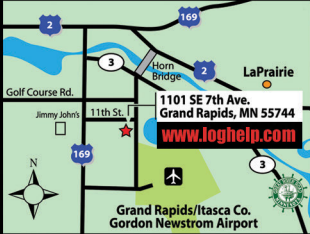
